My dear Dr. Meyer:

In reply to your letter of February 15, 1940, I do not want to seem too pessimistic about the outcome of claiming a refund for your damaged property, but it seems quite improbable that such claim could be based on the letter you received from your forwarding agent in Bremen.

In addition, it would involve a great expense which in view of the very questionable outcome should better not be risked.

And finally, I do not see any possibility of bringing up the case again before the Foreign Trade Zone once you have given instruction to have the balance of the good destroyed.
