

FLANDERS KIN KILLED

Widow of Atom Scientist Dies in Wisconsin Car Crash

MADISON, Wis., July 29 (AP)—Mrs. Sarah Flanders of Chicago, sister-in-law of Senator Ralph E. Flanders of Vermont and widow of an atomic scientist, was killed today in a car-truck crash.

Mrs. Flanders, 59 years old, was on her way home to Chicago when the car she was driving and a postal truck collided on a city street.

Her husband, Dr. Donald A. Flanders, 57, died on June 27 of what the police said was an overdose of barbiturates. His death was ruled a suicide.

Dr. Flanders, a brother of the Senator, was director of the applied mathematics division of the Atomic Energy Commission's Argonne National Laboratory near Chicago.
