As regards your question about the preferential treatment of those who have made mixed marriages in Germany: I have had a talk with Sir Wyndham Deedes who is playing a large part here in the settlement of Jewish refugees. He tells me that, so far, the particular type of refugee you mention has not received preferential treatments uch as is secured for persons in immediate personal danger. He says however, that he will bring the matter to the attention of those with whom he is working - and I am sure that he will, for he is one of the few people who always does what he says he will do.
